


## Kommunar State Farm, Korotich— August 27th, 1943


In August, 1943, fresh from their victory at Kursk, the Russians launched their Belgorod-Kharkov Offensive. Near the end of August, the Russian 5th Guards Tank Army was driving on Korotich in order to cut the Poltava-Kharkov rail line. Defending Korotich was the 2nd SS Panzer Division "Das Reich". In the seesaw fighting, SS Tigers would go head to head with Guards SU-152's. Fighting would center on the Kommunar State Farm, which would be taken by the Russians on August 26th with 10 SU-152's. As night fell on the 27th, the SS Tigers counter-attacked once again.

**VICTORY CONDITIONS:** The Germans win immediately upon destroying 5 x SU-152's. Otherwise the Germans win at game end by controlling buildings 4O6, 44BB8, and 44R7. Any other result if a Russian victory.

Special Rules/Notes:

- 1. EC are Moderate, with no wind at start. Kindling (B 25.11) and Bore Sighting (C 6.4) are N.A.
- 2. This scenario occurs at Dusk and therefore Low Visibility (E 3.1) is in effect with a +1 LV Hindrance at all ranges.
- 3. German 8-1 Armor Leaders must be placed in the MKIV's.

- 4. German Player may fire the LMG at Russian Tanks in order to highlight the targeted tank with tracer rounds. A successful to hit places tracer rounds on the enemy tank and provides a -1 for all Armor shots directed at the highlighted tank in that fire phase. Tracer rounds may only be place with direct fire and not as the result of a Fire Lane. Additionally, Rate of Fire is NA when attempting to highlight a tank with tracer rounds.
- 5. ATMM's (C13.7) are available to the Germans.



**Aftermath:** The SU152's operating in two groups of 5 had seen their infantry support move further forward. As dusk fell, the Germans moved in with Tigers and MKIV's accompanied by Panzergrenadiers. The Panzergrenadiers began highlighting the large SU-152's with tracer rounds. This aided the Tigers in targeting. In the ensuing fighting the Russians would lose four of the ten SU-152's and once more cede the farm to the Germans.
